- Property crimes – B & E – South Huron is getting hit hard – reminder to lock it or lose it
- Stolen vehicles continue to be an issue in this area
- Canadian revenue agency scam continues – public education and awareness – spread the word
- Clearance rate for property crimes – 17.2% – target is approximately 20%
- Racing occurrences have been a concern in the past six months
- Review of media reports relevant to South Huron
- Reminder when paddle boarding that you must wear your personal floatation device – charge for this offense is \$240.00

- Speed spy – mount on hydro poles and alternative locations unknown to the public – will provide an accurate version of traffic flow

- Exeter Rodeo – questioned if there would there be an opportunity for Board PR – information booth – lock it or lose it, self-reporting – initiative to lower calls for service and therefore reducing policing costs
- Discussed information sharing opportunities to advocate to the public
- Suggested that the Board work with Inspector and resources to create a video recording of initiatives (lock it or lose it, self-reporting) – share video with the public
- Table tents and coffee sleeves – promotion to the public – seasonal or topical information sharing
- Suggested co-branding with the Municipality
